

What is Domiciliary Residential Rehabilitation Treatment?

Domiciliary care is VA's oldest health care program. Established through legislation passed in the late 1860s, VHA Domiciliaries historically provided a home for disabled volunteer soldiers of the Civil War. At that time, Domiciliary care was established to provide services to economically-disadvantaged Veterans, and to this day remains committed to serving as a clinical rehabilitation, health care, and treatment program for male and female Veterans.

VA Butler Healthcare's Domiciliary Residential Rehabilitation Treatment Program (DRRTP)

is a **56-bed care facility** for eligible Veterans who deal with a multitude of issues such as **homelessness, mental health, substance abuse, and unemployment** matters. VA Butler Healthcare's Domiciliary is located on our 88-acre campus in rural Butler County, Pennsylvania.

DRRTP, or Dom, provides Veterans an opportunity to participate in a **residential, rehabilitative therapeutic community** to improve their quality of life through support, education, and advocacy. The goal is to successfully reintegrate Veterans back into the community.

Residents in the DRRTP participate **in a full range of rehabilitation services** including physical, behavioral, spiritual, psychosocial, addiction counseling, vocational, dietary, occupational therapy and intervention. Medical and mental health needs are also treated by various VA staff during a Veteran's stay. The DRRTP works with various VA Butler Healthcare services including:
