Housing Support Services

VA Butler Healthcare offers permanent or temporary housing and ongoing support services for homeless Veterans through the:

- Department of Housing and Urban Development and VA Supported Housing (HUD-VASH) Program
- Grant and Per Diem (GPD) Program
- Healthcare for Homeless Veterans (HCHV) Emergency Contract Housing
- Supportive Services for Veteran Families (SSVF)

Treatment Options

Healthcare for Homeless Veterans (HCHV) assists homeless Veterans in accessing appropriate healthcare and benefits. Treatment including primary care, substance abuse and mental health are available. Also available are:

- Homeless Veteran Dental Assistance
- Domiciliary Care for Homeless Veterans

Employment and Job Training

VA Butler Healthcare's **Compensated Work Therapy program** helps homeless Veterans earn pay while learning new job and life skills, relearning successful work habits and regaining a sense of self-esteem and self-worth.
