

Eligibility

You are eligible if you served:

- on active duty in a theater of combat operations during a period of war after the Gulf War
- in combat against a "hostile" force during a period of hostilities after November 11, 1998

You may be eligible as a combat Veteran if:

- you serve(d) in the National Guard and/or Reserve in support of OEF/OIF
- you were ordered to active duty by a federal declaration and served the full period for which you were called
- you were ordered to active duty and have separated from active military service with a discharge other than dishonorable conditions
- you have a service-connected condition

Enrollment

To begin the application process for enrollment, complete VA Form 10-10-EZ, APPLICATION FOR HEALTH BENEFITS.

Welcome Back Soldiers

Recently discharged Veterans may be eligible for up to **five years of FREE VA health care** from their end of active service for any military-related condition. After five years, co-payments depend on whether the illness or injury is determined to be service-connected.

Combat Veterans may also receive one-time comprehensive **dental treatment** if they were not provided treatment within 90 days before separation from active duty. They must apply within 180 days of their separation date. The time limit does not apply to Veterans with dental conditions resulting from service-connected wounds or injuries.
