- PTSD Residential Rehabilitation and Treatment Program
- Substance Abuse Residential and Treatment Programs

Returning Service Members

You may receive one-time dental treatment if you were not provided treatment within 90 days before separation from active duty. **You must apply within 180 days** of your separation date. The time limit does not apply if you have dental conditions resulting from service-connected wounds or injuries.

Veterans awarded a temporary total disability rating by Department of Veterans Affairs are not eligible for comprehensive outpatient dental services.



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Am I Eligible for VA Dental Care?

Eligibility for VA dental benefits is based on specific guidelines and differs significantly from eligibility requirements for medical care.

If you...	You are eligible for ...
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Have a service-connected compensable dental disability or condition 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Any needed dental care
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Are a former Prisoner of War 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Any needed dental care
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Have a 100% service-connected disability 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Any needed dental care
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Are participating in a VA vocational rehabilitation program 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Dental care needed to complete the program
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Have a service-connected and/or non-compensable dental condition or disability that existed when you were discharged or released from active duty of 90 days or more during the Persian Gulf War era 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • One-time dental care if you apply for dental services within 180 days of separation from active duty and your certificate of discharge does not indicate that all appropriate dental treatment had been rendered prior to discharge
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Have a service-connected non-compensable dental condition or disability 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Dental care needed for the service-connected condition
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Have a dental condition clinically determined by VA to be currently aggravating a service-connected medical condition 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Dental care needed to resolve the problem
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Are receiving outpatient care or are scheduled for inpatient care and require dental care for a condition complicating the medical condition currently under treatment 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Dental care needed to resolve the problem
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Are a Veteran in a VA Domiciliary program 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • From first day of admission, any medically necessary dental services

What if I need emergency dental care?

Emergency dental care will be given **only if** there is a **danger** to your life or health. If you are not eligible for dental treatment, we will evaluate you with the proper consult from your Primary Care Provider.

If you receive emergency dental care and are not eligible, you will be billed at the \$487 ineligible rate.

The VA does **not** consider the following to be emergencies:

- Broken or loose crowns
- Broken or loose bridges
- Broken or lost dentures
- Lost fillings
- Loose teeth
- Painful teeth
